An Act to increase the Duty on Tobacco TOBACCO INCREASE
DUTY.
 manufactured in New South Wales. [8th
 July, 1887.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to alter the duty imposed by the Preamble.
 “Tobacco Act 1884” upon tobacco manufactured in New South
 Wales Be it therefore enacted by the Queen’s Most Excellent Majesty
 by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
 Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled
 and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. In lieu of the duty now chargeable upon tobacco manufac- Increase of duty
on tobacco
manufactured or cut.
 tured in any tobacco factory licensed under the “Tobacco Act 1884” on
 entry for home consumption there shall be levied and collected for the
 use of Her Majesty an excise duty upon tobacco manufactured or cut
 a duty of one shilling and three pence per pound.

2. This Act may be cited as the “Tobacco Increase Duty Act Short title.
 of 1887” It shall be deemed to have come into force on the thirtieth Commencement &c.
 day of March one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven and from
 that date shall be read with and as part of the “Tobacco Act 1884.”
