SHERIFF'S FEES.

An Act to regulate the scale of Fees to be charged in the Sheriff's Office. [20th April, 1887.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient that the scale of fees chargeable in the Sheriff's Office should be fixed from time to time as the Governor with the advice of the Executive Council may appoint Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :—

1. It shall be lawful for the Governor with the advice of the Executive Council of the Colony from time to time to fix the scale of fees to be chargeable in the Sheriff's Office in respect of all matters pending at any time in the Supreme Court.

Short title.

2. This Act may be cited as the " Sheriff's Fees Act 1887."
