An Act to extend the period for the payment
of the Land Tax for the year 1896. [16th
November, 1896.]

LAND
AND INCOME TAX
(AMENDMENT).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. For and in respect of the payment without fine of amounts payable for land tax for the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six, the period of sixty days prescribed in section forty-eight of the Land and Income Tax Assessment Act of 1895 is hereby extended to ninety clear days after the same has become payable in the case of lands situate within the county of Cumberland, and is hereby extended to one hundred and twenty clear days after the same has become payable in the case of lands situate outside the said county of Cumberland. And for and in respect of the proceedings for recovery of amounts payable for land tax for the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six, the period of sixty days mentioned in section fifty of the said Act is also extended to ninety days in the former case and to one hundred and twenty days in the latter.
