NAMBUCCA RIVER  
HARBOUR WORKS.

An Act to sanction the carrying out of Harbour  
Works at Nambucca River. [24th October,  
1899.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of the Public Works Act of 1888, the Legislative Assembly did, by resolution, declare that it was expedient that a certain work, namely, Harbour Works at Nambucca River, as referred by the said Assembly to the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Public Works, should be carried out: And whereas the said resolution imposed a statutory duty

duty on the Secretary for Public Works to introduce a Bill into the said Assembly to sanction the carrying out of the said work : Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The carrying out of the said work (more particularly described <sup>Work sanctioned.</sup> in the Schedule to this Act) is hereby sanctioned, and the Secretary for Public Works, or the member of the Executive Council for the time being performing the duties of the said Secretary, is hereby authorised to undertake and carry out the said work, subject to the provisions of this Act, and for that purpose shall be, and shall have the powers and duties of, a Constructing Authority within the meaning of the Public Works Act of 1888.

2. The plan of the said work is the plan marked "Nambucca <sup>Plan of work.</sup> River Entrance," signed by the Secretary for Public Works and countersigned by the Engineer-in-Chief for Public Works, and deposited in the public office of the said Secretary.

3. The cost of carrying out the said work, estimated at forty- <sup>Costs, how to be defrayed.</sup> eight thousand five hundred pounds, may be defrayed from such Loan Votes as are now or may hereafter be applicable to that purpose, and shall not under any circumstances exceed the estimated cost by more than ten per centum.

4. This Act may be cited as the "Nambucca River Harbour <sup>Short title.</sup> Works, 1899."

## SCHEDULE.

*Improvements to the Entrance of the Nambucca River.*

1. The diversion of Warrell Creek into the main river by the construction of a rubble wall across the creek and the excavation of a cutting, and facing same with stone, marked "1" on plan.

2. The construction of a training-wall four thousand two hundred and fifty feet long extending in a south-westerly direction from near the root of the northern training-wall, marked "2" on plan.

3. The extension of the existing northern training-wall in an easterly direction, and the construction of a breakwater in continuation of the training-wall. Total length, one thousand seven hundred and fifty six feet, marked "3" on plan.
