

Act No. 78, 1900.

An Act to authorise certain annual payments to
be made towards the maintenance of the
Establishment of the Governor-General.
[11th December, 1900.]

GOVERNOR-
GENERAL'S
ESTABLISHMENT
CONTRIBUTION.

WHEREAS it is thought desirable that this Colony should contribute Preamble. to raise the annual amount to be received by the Governor-General to twenty thousand pounds: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Governor-General's Establishment Contribution Act, 1900." Short title.

2. It shall be lawful for the Governor, with the consent of the Governor-General, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, to cause to be paid annually from the Consolidated Revenue Fund Contribution of this Colony towards raising amount received by the Governor-General twenty thousand pounds.

Government Savings Bank (Commonwealth Arrangements).

Fund towards the maintenance of the establishment of the Governor-General an amount which bears the same proportion to the difference between twenty-thousand pounds and the amount appropriated by or under the Commonwealth of Australia Constitution Act for the salary of the Governor-General as the number of people of New South Wales bears to the number of people of the Commonwealth, excluding in both cases aboriginal natives.
