TRUCK.

An Act to amend the Truck Act of 1900. [19th
November, 1901.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Subscriptions to
hospitals.

1. That clause ten subsection one, of the Truck Act of 1900, be amended by adding the words “or where within the county of Yancowinna an employer or his agent deducts from the wages due to any workman the amount of a voluntary donation or subscription to a hospital fund.”

Short title.¹

2. This Act may be cited as the “Truck Act Amendment Act of 1901.”
