

## Act No. 8, 1902.

TREASURY BILLS  
 DEFICIENCY  
 (AMENDMENT).

### An Act to amend the Treasury Bills Deficiency Act, 1900. [15th January, 1902.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Treasury Bills Deficiency (Amendment) Act, 1901."

Amendment of section 12.

2. Section twelve of the Treasury Bills Deficiency Act, 1900, is amended by substituting the words "one thousand nine hundred and two" for the words "one thousand nine hundred and one" in that section.

Amendment of preamble and section 2.

3. (1) The preamble and section two of the Treasury Bills Deficiency Act, 1900, are amended by the substitution of the words "seven hundred and fifty-five thousand one hundred and eighty pounds" for the words "nine hundred and thirty thousand nine hundred and sixty-five pounds" in that preamble and section.

Amendment of Schedule.

(2) The Schedule to the said Act is amended, and shall read as under:—

Amendment of sections 12, 14, & 15.

4. Sections twelve, fourteen, and fifteen of the Treasury Bills Deficiency Act, 1900, are amended by substituting the words "one hundred thousand pounds" for the words "two hundred and fifty thousand pounds" in those sections.
