An Act to amend the Navigation Act of 1901,
by providing for issue of regulations. [10th
December, 1904.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative
Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the
authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the “Navigation Amendment
(Regulations) Act, 1904,” and shall be read as one with the Navigation
Act, 1901, hereinafter called the Principal Act.

Regulations.

2. The Governor may make all regulations necessary to carry
out the provisions of the Principal Act.
