

Act No. 35, 1905.

VAGRANCY
(AMENDMENT).

An Act to declare fan-tan and pak-a-pu to be unlawful games; to amend the Vagrancy Act, 1902; and for other purposes. [9th December, 1905.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Vagrancy (Amendment) Act, 1905."

Unlawful games.

2. The games called respectively fan-tan and pak-a-pu or any similar game of chance are declared to be unlawful games.

Person selling ticket
or chance deemed
rogue and vagabond.

3. Any person who gives or sells any ticket or chance, or share in any ticket or chance, in any such game shall be guilty of an offence under subsection two of section four of the Vagrancy Act, 1902, and shall be deemed a rogue and vagabond within the meaning of the said Act.
