

Act No. 6, 1907.

An Act to create the office of Minister for Agriculture; to establish a Department of Agriculture; and for other purposes. [26th November, 1907.]

DEPARTMENT OF
AGRICULTURE.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the “Department of Agriculture short title. Act, 1907.”
2. The Governor may, by proclamation in the Gazette, create the office of Minister of Agriculture. The said office shall be an office of profit under the Crown, created by Act of Parliament as an office of the Executive Government.
3. The Minister of Agriculture shall be a responsible Minister of the Crown, having management and control of the Department of Agriculture, which the Governor is hereby empowered to establish.
