**MAITLAND HOSPITAL
(INFECTIOUS
WARDS) ENABLING.**

An Act to enable the committee of the Maitland Hospital to withdraw certain moneys from its fixed deposit account for the purpose of erecting and furnishing infectious wards.
[2nd April, 1912.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

Authority to

1. This Act may be cited as the "Maitland Hospital (Infectious Wards) Enabling Act, 1912."

2. The committee of the Maitland Hospital may, with the consent of the trustees of the said hospital, or of a majority of them, withdraw a sum of money, not to exceed one thousand five hundred pounds, from the amount in any fixed deposit account standing to its credit or to that of the said trustees at any bank, for the purpose of, and may expend such money in, erecting and furnishing new infectious wards.
