

Act No. 8, 1912.

An Act to enable the municipal council of the City of Sydney to erect and let dwelling-houses, and for that purpose to acquire land; to extend the borrowing powers of the said council; to amend certain Acts relating to the corporation of the City of Sydney; and for purposes consequent thereon or incidental thereto. [4th April, 1912.]

CORPORATION
(DWELLING-HOUSES)

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Preliminary.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Sydney Corporation Short title.
(Dwelling-houses) Act, 1912," and shall be construed with the Sydney Corporation Act, 1902, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Act.

Dwelling-houses.

2. Section sixteen of the Sydney Corporation Amendment Power of council to purchase or resume.
Act, 1905, as amended by subsequent Acts, is hereby amended by the addition after the words "Municipal Council of Sydney Electric Lighting Act" of the words "or for the purpose of the erection of dwelling-houses within the boundaries of the city of Sydney."

3. The council may, on any land which has been or may Power to erect dwelling-houses.
hereafter be purchased or resumed by it for the purpose of carrying out improvements in or remodelling any portion of the city, or which may hereafter be purchased or resumed for the purpose of erecting dwelling-houses thereon, erect dwelling-houses, and may let them on such terms and on such conditions as the council thinks fit.

4. The expenses of and in connection with the erection of such Expenses, how defrayed.
buildings may be defrayed out of moneys borrowed for that purpose.

Power to borrow.

5. Section twenty-three of the Sydney Corporation (Amendment) Act, 1905, is hereby amended by the insertion after the words "Municipal Council of Sydney Electric Lighting Act" of the words "or of the Principal Act, or any Act amending the same, including the Sydney Corporation (Dwelling-houses) Act, 1912."
