

STATE DEBT AND SINKING FUND (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 11, 1914.

George V, An Act to amend the State Debt and Sinking Fund
No. 11. Act, 1904. [Assented to, 16th April, 1914.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—

Short title. **1.** This Act may be cited as the “State Debt and
Sinking Fund (Amendment) Act, 1914.”

Amendment
of s. 7. **2.** The following proviso is added to section seven
of the State Debt and Sinking Fund Act, 1904:—

Amount of
deficiency on
C. R. account
to be repaid. “Provided that where at the close of any
financial year there is a deficiency on the Con-
solidated Revenue Account, the Commissioners
shall repay to the Consolidated Revenue Fund any
amount, not being greater than such deficiency,
which has been issued from the said fund to the
Commissioners during the said year.”
