

## GOVERNMENT SAVINGS BANK AMENDMENT ACT.

---

### Act No. 17, 1914.

**George V, An Act to amend the Government Savings Bank No. 17.** Act, 1906, and the Government Savings Bank Amendment Act, 1913; and for purposes consequent thereon or incidental thereto. [Assented to, 25th August, 1914.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**Short title.** **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Government Savings Bank Amendment Act, 1914," and shall be construed with the Government Savings Bank Act, 1906, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Act.

**Withdrawal of deposits and interest.** **2.** Section forty-one, subsection one, of the Principal Act, as amended by the Government Savings Bank Act, 1906, is hereby repealed, and the following section is substituted therefor:—

Deposits and interest payable thereon may be withdrawn on application in the prescribed form by the depositor or the person legally entitled to claim on his behalf.

The Commissioners may prescribe conditions and period of notice to be given before such withdrawals are payable.
