

# CONSTITUTION AMENDMENT ACT.

---

## Act No. 33, 1914.

An Act to amend the Constitution Act, 1902, with **George V,**  
regard to the qualification of Members of the **No. 33,**  
Legislative Assembly. [Assented to, 14th  
December, 1914.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,  
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-  
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South  
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of  
the same, as follows :—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the “Constitution Short title.  
Amendment Act, 1914.”

**2.** Nothing in section twenty-six or section twenty-  
seven of the Constitution Act, 1902, shall be deemed to Sections 26  
and 27 not to  
apply to
