

CONSTITUTION AMENDMENT ACT.

Act No. 33, 1914.

An Act to amend the Constitution Act, 1902, with George V,
No. 33, regard to the qualification of Members of the Legislative Assembly. [Assented to, 14th December, 1914.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Constitution Short title.
Amendment Act, 1914."

2. Nothing in section twenty-six or section twenty-seven of the Constitution Act, 1902, shall be deemed to Sections 26 and 27 not to apply to officers of navy or army. have extended or shall extend to any person who apply to officers of navy or army. has accepted or held or may hereafter accept or hold any office of profit in His Majesty's navy or army.
