

SUPPLY ACT.

Act No. 18, 1915.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards the Services of the Year 1915-1916, and out of the Public Works Fund, and out of the General Loan Account for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan. [Assented to, 27th July, 1915.]

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Four millions nine hundred and fifty-five thousand six hundred pounds, that is to say—

Preamble.

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of One million six hundred and two thousand three hundred pounds, being the

sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of July, August, and September, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen; and the sum of Two millions and twenty thousand pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule A hereto annexed.

Out of the Public Works Fund, the sum of One hundred and forty-two thousand six hundred pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule B hereto annexed.

Out of the General Loan Account, the sum of One million one hundred and ninety thousand seven hundred pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule C hereto annexed :

And whereas we desire to make good out of the said Funds and the General Loan Account the sum so granted to His Majesty : Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Three millions six hundred and twenty-two thousand three hundred pounds, of which the sum of One million six hundred and two thousand three hundred pounds is to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifteen, to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of July, August, and September, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1915–1916; and the sum of Two millions and twenty thousand pounds is to be expended for the Services specified in Schedule A hereto annexed.

2. Out of the Public Works Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty the sum of One hundred and forty-two thousand six hundred pounds for the Services specified in Schedule B hereto annexed. George V.

3. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Audit Act, 1902, there shall and may be issued out of the General Loan Account and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of One million one hundred and ninety thousand seven hundred pounds for the Services specified in Schedule C hereto annexed. £1,190,700

4. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and the Public Works Fund and the General Loan Account respectively. Treasurer to

5. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders. And the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly. 6. This Act may be cited as the "Supply Act, 1915." Short title.
