

SYDNEY CORPORATION (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 37, 1915.

An Act to amend the Sydney Corporation Act, George V,
1902, in respect to the hours of voting. No. 37.
[Assented to, 24th November, 1915.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the “Sydney Corpora- Short title.

- (b) by the addition of the following proviso:—
“Provided that if at the last mentioned hour
any citizens are in the polling-booth and
desire to vote, the votes of such citizens
shall be taken, and for that purpose the voting
shall not close until such citizens have voted.”
