

TRADES HALL AND LITERARY INSTITUTE AMENDMENT ACT.

Act No. 17, 1916.

An Act to amend the Trades Hall and Literary Institute Act of 1893. [Assented to, 19th April, 1916.] George V,
No. 17.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Trades Hall and Literary Institute Amendment Act, 1916." Short title.

2. Section one of the Trades Hall and Literary Institute Act of 1893 is amended by omitting the word "fifteen" and substituting in lieu thereof the words "twenty-five". Increase of
