

THE CATHEDRAL CLOSE AMENDING ACT.

Act No. 18, 1916.

George V, An Act to amend the Act thirty-two Victoria
No. 18. number four, intituled an Act to authorise
the appropriation of the old burial ground or
cathedral close in Sydney to certain municipi-
pal and other public purposes. [Assented to,
19th April, 1916.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Act
thirty-two Victoria number four, intituled "An Act to
authorise the appropriation of the Old Burial Ground
or Cathedral Close in Sydney to certain municipal and
other public purposes," it shall be lawful for the
trustees for the time being of the land comprised in the
Schedule to the Act thirty-four Victoria number six
amending the said Act from time to time to alter the
dwelling-house and buildings now erected on the said
land, and within the limits of the said land to make
additions to the said dwelling-house and buildings and
to permit the use of the same for all or any of the
purposes following, namely, a residence for the chief
officiating minister of the said Cathedral, a church
house and offices, and otherwise in connection with the
said Cathedral and the administration of the affairs of
the Church of England in the diocese of Sydney.

Short title.

2. This Act may be cited as "The Cathedral Close
Amending Act, 1916."
