

GOVERNMENT SAVINGS BANK AMENDMENT ACT.

Act No. 26, 1916.

An Act to amend the Government Savings Bank, George V, No. 26. Act, 1906; and for purposes consequent thereon or incidental thereto. [Assented to, 19th April, 1916.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Government short title. Savings Bank Amendment Act, 1916," and shall be construed with the Government Savings Bank Act, 1906 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Act).

2. Section fifty-three of the Principal Act is amended Amendment of s. 53 of Principal Act. by omitting after the word "interest" the words "not exceeding four pounds per centum per annum."
