

SUPPLY ACT (No. 2).

Act No. 32, 1916.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards the Services of the Year 1916-1917, and out of the Public Works Fund, and out of the General Loan Account for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan. [Assented to, 1st September, 1916.]

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled,
have

Preamble.

George V, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of
No. 32. One million eight hundred and seventy-six thousand
 nine hundred pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund the sum
 of Four hundred and twenty-eight thousand
 one hundred and fifty pounds, being the sum
 required to defray the expenses of the various
 Departments and Services of the State during
 the month of September, or following month
 of the financial year ending thirtieth day of
 June, one thousand nine hundred and seven-
 teen; and the sum of Seven hundred and
 eighty-four thousand five hundred pounds for
 the Services set forth in Schedule A hereto
 annexed.

Out of the Public Works Fund, the sum of
 Forty-five thousand five hundred pounds for
 the Services set forth in Schedule B hereto
 annexed.

Out of the General Loan Account, the sum of Six
 hundred and eighteen thousand seven hundred
 and fifty pounds for the Services set forth in
 Schedule C hereto annexed:

And whereas we desire to make good out of the said
 Funds and the General Loan Account the sum so granted
 to His Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the King's
 Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and
 consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative
 Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled,
 and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New
 South Wales there shall and may be issued and applied
 for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be
 granted to His Majesty, the sum of One million two
 hundred and twelve thousand six hundred and fifty
 pounds, of which the sum of Four hundred and
 twenty-eight thousand one hundred and fifty pounds
 is to be expended at the rates which have been
 sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of
 June, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen, to defray
 the expenses of the various Departments and Services of
 the State during the month of September, or follow-
 ing month of the financial year ending thirtieth
 day

day of June, one thousand nine hundred and seven- George V,
teen, subject to the rate of any reduction that may No. 32.
hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year
1916-1917; and the sum of Seven hundred and eighty-
four thousand five hundred pounds is to be expended for
the Services specified in Schedule A hereto annexed.

4. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums Treasurer to
for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such pay under
proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in Governor's
writing under his hand, and directed to the said Warrant or
Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. Order.
And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon
and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and
the Public Works Fund and the General Loan Account
respectively.

5. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to Treasurer to
time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by have credit
