

SYDNEY HARBOUR TONNAGE RATES ACT.

Act No. 62, 1916.

An Act to amend the Sydney Harbour Rates Act, George V,
1904; and for purposes consequent thereon No. 62.
or incidental thereto. [Assented to, 27th
November, 1916.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the “Sydney Harbour Short title.
Tonnage Rates Act, 1916.”

2. Section seven of the Sydney Harbour Rates Act, Repeal of
1904, is repealed, and the following section inserted in s. 7.
the place thereof:—

7. The tonnage rates to be levied shall be at the Scale of
rate of one-half penny for each ton of the gross tonnage rates.
tonnage measurement of the vessel for each
complete period of twenty-four hours, and for
periods of less than twenty-four hours at the rate
of one-eighth of a penny for each period of six
hours or part thereof.

3. Section twelve of the same Act is repealed, and the Repeal of
following section is inserted in the place thereof:— s. 12.

12. For the purposes of this Act the latest Evidence of
publication of Lloyd's Register shall be evidence tonnage.
of the tonnage of all vessels mentioned therein.
