

UNIVERSITY (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 78, 1916.

George V, An Act to increase the endowment of the University No. 78. of Sydney, and for that purpose to amend the University (Amendment) Act, 1912, and certain other Acts. [Assented to, 20th December, 1916.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "University (Amendment) Act, 1916."

This Act shall commence and come into force on the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and seventeen.

Increase of endowment.

2. (1) Subsection one of section six of the University (Amendment) Act, 1912, is amended by substituting the word "thirty" for the word "twenty" in that subsection.

(2) The annual endowment of the University of Sydney out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund is further increased by the sum of two thousand pounds for establishing and maintaining a chair of architecture, and for purposes incidental thereto.
