

DEFAMATION (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 14, 1917.

George V. An Act to amend the Defamation Act, 1912.
No. 14. [Assented to, 7th November, 1917.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the “Defamation (Amendment) Act, 1917.”

Repeal of
s. 31.

2. Section thirty-one of the Defamation Act, 1912, is repealed.

Saving.

3. This Act shall not apply to any action or other proceeding commenced before the passing of this Act.
