

FORESTRY (TEMPORARY COMMISSIONERS) AMENDMENT ACT.

Act No. 16, 1917.

An Act to amend the Forestry (Temporary Commissioners) Act, 1916. [Assented to, 7th November, 1917.] George V,
No. 16.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the “Forestry (Temporary Commissioners) Amendment Act, 1917.” Short title.

2. The Forestry (Temporary Commissioners) Act, 1916, is amended by omitting the words “or until the expiration of six months from the commencement of this Act, whichever first happens,” at the end of subsection two of section two. Amendment of the Forestry (Temporary Commissioners) Act, 1916.
