

## COAL MINES REGULATION (AMENDMENT) ACT.

---

Act No. 3, 1917.

An Act to amend the Coal Mines Regulation Act, 1912. [Assented to, 18th August, 1917.] George V,  
No. 3.

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the “Coal Mines Regulation (Amendment) Act, 1917.” Short title.

**2.** Section fifty-four of the Coal Mines Regulation Act, 1912, is amended by inserting at the commencement of rule forty, and before the words “No person” the words “Except by consent of the Minister”. Amendment of s. 54.
