

## WESTERN LANDS (DECLARATORY) ACT.

Act No. 10, 1918.

George V, No. 10. An Act to provide for the extension of the term of office of the Commissioners of the Western Land Board as from the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and eighteen ; to validate certain powers exercised and acts done on and after the said date ; and for purposes consequent thereon or incidental thereto. [Assented to, 19th March, 1918.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Short title. **1.** This Act may be cited as the “Western Lands (Declaratory) Act, 1918.”

Land Board. **2.** The Commissioners of the Western Land Board of New South Wales holding office as such Commissioners on the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and seventeen, shall be and be deemed to have been duly appointed from the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and eighteen, Commissioners of the said board for a period of twelve months from the said first day of January ; and any vacancy occurring during such period may be filled by the Governor for the unexpired portion thereof.

All powers exercised and all acts done by them or by any of them purporting to have been exercised or done as such Commissioners on and after the said first day of January, and before the commencement of this Act, shall be and be deemed to have been as valid as if exercised or done by Commissioners of the Western Land Board of New South Wales duly appointed under the Western Lands Act of 1901.
