

TRUCK (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 47, 1918.

An Act to amend the Truck Act of 1900 and ^{George V,} the Truck Act Amendment Act of 1901. ^{No. 47.}
[Assented to, 19th December, 1918.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Truck (Amendment) Act, 1918." Short title.

2. Section ten of the Truck Act of 1900, as amended by the Truck Act Amendment Act of 1901, is amended by omitting the words "within the county of Yaneo-^{of s. 10 of the} winna" and by adding at the end of the section the words "or to a medical guarantee fund." ^{Truck Act of 1900.}
