

SYDNEY CORPORATION (DECLARATORY) ACT.

Act No. 6, 1918.

George V, An Act to amend the Sydney Corporation (Amendment) Act, 1908, and the Sydney Corporation (Amendment) (No. 2) Act, 1916 ; and for other purposes. [Assented to, 12th March, 1918.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the “ Sydney Corporation (Declaratory) Act, 1918.”

Amendment of s. 11A of Act of 1908.

2. Section 11A of the Sydney Corporation (Amendment) Act, 1908, inserted in that Act by section seven of the Sydney Corporation (Amendment) (No. 2) Act, 1916, is amended by substituting for “ the passing of this Act ” the words “ the thirteenth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen.” This amendment shall take effect as from the said day.
