

UNIVERSITY (BUILDING) ACT.

Act No. 12, 1919.

George V. An Act to appropriate and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund certain sums for the Senate of the University of Sydney; and for purposes consequent thereon or incidental thereto. [Assented to, 26th November, 1919.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title. **1.** This Act may be cited as the “University (Building) Act, 1919.”

2. There shall be paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund annually during the financial year commencing the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, and during each of the five next following financial years, to the Senate of the University of Sydney, the sum of fifty thousand pounds, to be expended in the erection of buildings for or in connection with the said University.

Each such annual amount is hereby specially appropriated, and shall in each of the said years be paid in such instalments and at such times as the Colonial Treasurer may think fit.

In this section "financial year" means the period from the first day of July in one year to the thirtieth day of June in the following year.
