

NARRANDERA WATER SUPPLY ACT.

Act No. 32, 1919.

George V, An Act to sanction the carrying out of works to No. 32. augment the scheme of water supply for the municipality of Narrandera; to amend the Public Works Act, 1912, and the Country Towns Water and Sewerage Acts, 1880–1905; and for purposes consequent thereon or incidental thereto. [Assented to, 16th December, 1919.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the “Narrandera Water Supply Act, 1919.”

Works sanctioned.

2. The carrying out of the works (more particularly described in the Schedule to this Act) is hereby sanctioned, and the Minister for Public Works, or the member of the Executive Council for the time being performing the duties of the said Minister, is hereby authorised to undertake and carry out the said works, subject to the provisions of this Act, and for that purpose shall be and shall have the power of a Constructing Authority within the meaning of the Public Works Act, 1912.

Authorised work.

3. The said works shall be deemed to be authorised works for the purposes of the Public Works Act, 1912, and the provisions of the said Act, save as provided by this Act, shall apply thereto.

4. The provisions of sections thirty-four, thirty-five, ^{George V,} ^{No. 32.} thirty-six, and thirty-seven of the Public Works Act, 1912, shall not apply to the said works, but the provisions ^{Application of provisions of Public Works Act, 1912.} of section thirty-eight shall apply to any contracts for carrying out such works.

5. The plan of the said works is the plan marked ^{The plan.} "Narrandera Water Supply Amplification Scheme," signed by the Minister for Public Works and countersigned by the Chief Engineer for Water Supply and Sewerage, and deposited in the public office of the said Minister.

6. The cost of carrying out the said works of water supply is estimated at twenty-seven thousand pounds ^{Cost, and how to be defrayed.} (exclusive of land resumptions), and may be defrayed from such Loan Votes as are now or may hereafter be applicable to the purpose, or from appropriations of the Public Works Fund, or partly from such votes and partly from such appropriations, and shall not, under any circumstances, exceed the estimated cost by more than ten per centum.

7. Notwithstanding anything contained in the ^{Amendment of Country Towns Water and Sewerage Acts, 1880-1905, 1905.} Country Towns Water and Sewerage Acts, 1880-1905, the Governor may from time to time fix the rate of interest (which may exceed four per centum per annum) to be paid by the council of the said municipality in respect of the cost of the said works, and may thereupon by notification alter the instalments of such cost payable by the said council.

SCHEDULE.

CONSTRUCTION of the following works to augment the scheme of water supply for the Municipality of Narrandera.

1. Duplicate service reservoirs.
2. Rising main.
3. Reticulation.
4. Pumping plant.
5. Engine house and approaches thereto with suction main, pump well, staging, coagulant plant and fencing.
6. Water level indicator.
7. Incidental Works.

The whole to be subject to such modifications as the Constructing Authority may think desirable.
