

## SUPPLY ACT (No. 2).

---

Act No. 11, 1920.

**George V, An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards the Services of the Year 1920-1921, and out of the Public Works Fund, and out of the General Loan Account for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan. [Assented to, 1st November, 1920.]**

**Preamble.** WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have

have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of ~~George V,~~ Two millions eight hundred and sixty thousand two hundred pounds, that is to say— **No. 11.**

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of Four hundred and forty-four thousand pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the month of November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one; and the sum of One million four hundred and ninety-six thousand two hundred pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule A hereto annexed.

Out of the Public Works Fund, the sum of Thirty-two thousand two hundred pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule B hereto annexed.

Out of the General Loan Account, the sum of Eight hundred and eighty-seven thousand eight hundred pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule C hereto annexed:

And whereas we desire to make good out of the said Funds and the General Loan Account the sum so granted to His Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New ~~£1,940,200~~ South Wales there shall and may be issued and applied ~~may be issued out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.~~ for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of One million nine hundred and forty thousand two hundred pounds, of which the sum of Four hundred and forty-four thousand pounds is to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the month of November, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the

**George V,** the expenditure of the year 1920-1921; and the sum of  
**No. 11.** One million four hundred and ninety-six thousand two hundred pounds is to be expended for the Services specified in Schedule A hereto annexed.

**£32,200 may be issued out of the Public Works Fund.** **2.** Out of the Public Works Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty the sum of thirty-two thousand two hundred pounds for the Services specified in Schedule B hereto annexed.

**£887,800 may be issued out of the General Loan Account.** **3.** Notwithstanding the provisions of the Audit Act, 1902, there shall and may be issued out of the General Loan Account and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of eight hundred and eighty-seven thousand eight hundred pounds for the Services specified in Schedule C hereto annexed.

**Treasurer to pay under Governor's Warrant or Order.** **4.** The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and the Public Works Fund and the General Loan Account respectively.

**Treasurer to have credit and receipts to discharge him.** **5.** The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders. And the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

**Short title.** **6.** This Act may be cited as the "Supply Act (No. 2), 1920."
