

GOVERNMENT RAILWAYS (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 26, 1920.

George V, An Act to authorise the Railway Commissioners for
No. 26. New South Wales to acquire, hold, develop,
and work coal mines within the State of New
South Wales; to amend the Government
Railways Act, 1912; and for purposes con-
nected therewith. [Assented to, 29th Decem-
ber, 1920.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—

Short title. **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Government
Railways (Amendment) Act, 1920." **2.**

2. The Government Railways Act, 1912, is amended **George V,**
by inserting after section seventeen the following new **No. 26.**

Power of
Commissioners to
acquire coal
mines.

17A. It shall be lawful for the Commissioners—

- (a) to acquire, under the provisions of the Mining Act, 1906, and any Act amending the same, and to hold, develop, and work a coal mine or coal mines within the State of New South Wales and to carry out all works and do all things necessary or proper in connection therewith ; and
- (b) to use, sell, or otherwise dispose of the coal or any product of the coal won from such mine.
