

## GOVERNMENT RAILWAYS (AMENDMENT) ACT.

---

Act No. 26, 1920.

**George V,** An Act to authorise the Railway Commissioners for  
**No. 26.** New South Wales to acquire, hold, develop,  
and work coal mines within the State of New  
South Wales; to amend the Government  
Railways Act, 1912; and for purposes con-  
nected therewith. [Assented to, 29th Decem-  
ber, 1920.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,  
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-  
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South  
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of  
the same, as follows:—

Short title. **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Government  
Railways (Amendment) Act, 1920." **2.**

**2.** The Government Railways Act, 1912, is amended by inserting after section seventeen the following new sections :—

17A. It shall be lawful for the Commissioners—

Power of

sioners to  
acquire coal  
mines.

- (a) to acquire, under the provisions of the Mining Act, 1906, and any Act amending the same, and to hold, develop, and work a coal mine or coal mines within the State of New South Wales and to carry out all works and do all things necessary or proper in connection therewith; and
- (b) to use, sell, or otherwise dispose of the coal or any product of the coal won from such mine.
