

SYDNEY HARBOUR TRUST (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 34, 1920.

An Act to amend the Sydney Harbour Trust Act, George V,
1900 ; and for purposes connected therewith. No. 34.
[Assented to, 29th December, 1920.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the “Sydney Harbour Trust (Amendment) Act, 1920.” Short title.

2. This Act shall commence on the first day of July, Commence-
one thousand nine hundred and twenty. ment.

3. Section seventy-five of the Sydney Harbour Trust Act, 1900, is amended by omitting the words “being not less than three and a half, and not more than four per centum per annum” and by inserting in lieu thereof the words “being interest at a rate not exceeding the average rate of interest paid by the Government on loan moneys.” Amendment of Sydney Harbour Trust Act, 1900, s. 75.
