

SYDNEY HARBOUR TRUST (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 34, 1920.

An Act to amend the Sydney Harbour Trust Act, ^{George V,} 1900; and for purposes connected therewith. ^{No. 34.}
[Assented to, 29th December, 1920.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Sydney Harbour ^{Short title.} Trust (Amendment) Act, 1920."

2. This Act shall commence on the first day of July, ^{Commencement.} one thousand nine hundred and twenty.

3. Section seventy-five of the Sydney Harbour Trust ^{Amendment} Act, 1900, is amended by omitting the words "being ^{of Sydney} Harbour not less than three and a half, and not more than four ^{Trust Act,} per centum per annum" and by inserting in lieu thereof ^{1900,} ^{s. 75.} the words "being interest at a rate not exceeding the average rate of interest paid by the Government on loan moneys."
