

## CLOSER SETTLEMENT PURCHASES VALIDATION ACT.

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Act No. 11, 1923.

An Act to validate certain settlement purchases ; George V,  
and for that purpose to amend certain Acts. No. 11.  
[Assented to, 4th October, 1923.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,  
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative  
Council and Legislative Assembly of New South  
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of  
the same, as follows :—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the "Closer Settlement short title.  
Purchases Validation Act, 1923." **2.**

**2.** The persons named in the first column of the Schedule are hereby declared to have been, as from the twenty-fifth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, settlement purchasers, under and subject to the provisions of the Closer Settlement Act, 1904, and any Act amending the same, of the portions of land, particulars of which are set forth in the Schedule opposite to the names of such persons respectively, and the said portions of land are hereby declared, as from the said date, to have vested in and to have been held by the said persons respectively, as settlement purchases, under and subject to the provisions of the said Acts.
