

WOLLONGONG SEWERAGE ACT.

Act No. 38, 1923.

An Act to sanction the construction of a system of sewerage for the Municipality of Wollongong; and for purposes consequent thereon or incidental thereto. [Assented to, 21st December, 1923.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Wollongong Sewerage Act, 1923." Short title.

2. The carrying out of the work described in the Schedule to this Act is hereby sanctioned, and the Secretary for Public Works is hereby empowered to carry out the same.

No. 38. "Wollongong Sewerage Works," signed by the Secre-
Plan of work. tary for Public Works, and countersigned by the
Chief Engineer for Water Supply and Sewerage, and
deposited in the public office of the said Secretary.

Cost. **4.** The cost of carrying out the said work (exclusive
of land resumptions) is estimated at sixty-six thousand
six hundred and forty pounds, and such estimated cost
shall not, under any circumstances, be exceeded by
more than ten per centum.

SCHEDULE.

THE construction of main and reticulation sewers, pumping stations,
rising mains, treatment works, lines for transmission of electric current
for power, telephone, or signalling purposes, and all works incidental
thereto, necessary for the sewerage of the Municipality of Wollongong,
subject to such alterations and modifications as may be considered
desirable by the Constructing Authority.
