

## SUPPLY ACT (No. 2).

## Act No. 37, 1929.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Government Railways and Tramways Fund, and the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, towards the Services of the Year 1929-1930, and out of the General Loan Account for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan. [Assented to, 29th November, 1929.]

**W**HEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Three millions eight hundred and seventy-one thousand nine hundred and twenty pounds, that is to say—

Preamble.

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of One million three hundred and eighty thousand eight hundred pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the month of December or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty.

Out of the Government Railways and Tramways Fund, the sum of One million five hundred and seventy-three thousand four hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance, and working expenses of the Government Railways and Tramways during the month of December or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty.

Out of the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, the sum of Thirty thousand nine hundred pounds to defray salaries, maintenance, and working expenses and other expenses of the Sydney

Harbour Trust during the month of December or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty.

Out of the General Loan Account, the sum of Eight hundred and eighty-six thousand eight hundred and twenty pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule A hereto annexed :

And whereas we desire to make good out of the said Funds and the General Loan Account the sum so granted to His Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of One million three hundred and eighty thousand eight hundred pounds, to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine, to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the month of December, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1929-1930.

**2.** Out of the Government Railways and Tramways Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of One million five hundred and seventy-three thousand four hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine, to defray the salaries, maintenance, and working expenses and other expenses of the Railways and Tramways during the month of December or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1929-1930.

**3.** Out of the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Thirty thousand nine hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine, to defray the salaries, maintenance, and working expenses and other expenses of the Sydney Harbour Trust during the month of December or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June one thousand nine hundred and thirty, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1929-1930.

£30,900 may be issued out of the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund.

**4.** Notwithstanding the provisions of the Audit Act, 1902, there shall and may be issued out of the General Loan Account and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Eight hundred and eighty-six thousand eight hundred and twenty pounds for the Services specified in Schedule A hereto annexed.

£886,820 may be issued out of the General Loan Account.

**5.** The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Government Railways and Tramways Fund, the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, and the General Loan Account respectively.

Treasurer to pay under Governor's Warrant or Order.

**6.** The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders. And the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

Treasurer to have credit and receipts to discharge him.

**7.** This Act may be cited as the "Supply Act (No. 2), 1929."
