

## PARLIAMENTARY ALLOWANCES AND SALARIES ACT.

Act No. 8, 1930.

An Act to reduce the allowances to Members of the Legislative Assembly and the salaries of Ministers of the Crown and of certain other persons; to amend the Constitution Act, 1902, and certain other Acts; to repeal the Parliamentary Allowances and Salaries Act, 1925; and for purposes connected therewith. George V.

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the "Parliamentary Allowances and Salaries Act, 1930." Short title  
and com-  
mencement.

(2) The Constitution Act, 1902, as amended by subsequent Acts, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall commence upon the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and thirty.

**2.** The Principal Act is amended by omitting from section twenty-eight the words "eight hundred and seventy-five pounds" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "seven hundred and forty-three pounds fifteen shillings." Amendment

**3.** The Principal Act is further amended—

(a) by omitting from subsection one of section forty-one the words "twenty-two thousand three hundred and forty-five pounds" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "twenty-two thousand and fifty-three pounds five shillings"; Further

- (b) by omitting from the Third Schedule the figures "1945 0 0" and by inserting in lieu thereof the figures "1653 5 0";
- (c) by omitting from the said Third Schedule the figures "14,295 0 0" and by inserting in lieu thereof the figures "14,003 5 0."

Appropriation for salaries of Ministers.

**4.** There is hereby specially appropriated out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund an annual amount for the payment as from the commencement of this Act of the salaries of the Ministers of the Crown, being members of the Executive Council, as hereinafter mentioned, at the rate of nineteen thousand nine hundred and seven pounds per annum :—

Appropriation for salaries of President, Speaker, and Chairman of Committees.

**5.** There is hereby specially appropriated out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund an annual amount for the payment, as from the commencement of this Act, of the salaries of the persons for the time being filling the offices hereinafter mentioned at the rate of three thousand nine hundred and eighty-six pounds ten shillings per annum :—
