WHEREAS

Preamble.

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Eighty-four thousand five hundred and sixty-two pounds out of the Closer Settlement Fund for the Services of the Year 1931-1932: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of the State of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**APPROPRIATIONS OUT OF THE CLOSER SETTLEMENT FUND.**

Appropriations.

**1.** Out of the Closer Settlement Fund there is hereby appropriated, and may be issued and applied for or towards the several uses and purposes hereinafter expressed:—The sum of Eighty-four thousand five hundred and sixty-two pounds:—

Treasurer or lawful Authority shall pay by warrant or order.

**2.** There shall be issued and paid the said sum for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor by any warrant or order in writing under his hand and directed to the Colonial Treasurer or other lawful authority may from

from time to time order and direct, and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the said fund.

**3.** The said Colonial Treasurer or other lawful Authority shall in their respective accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum or sums of money paid by him or them in pursuance of such warrant or order in writing as aforesaid, and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Colonial Treasurer or other lawful Authority in passing the said accounts for any such sums as may be therein mentioned, and he or they shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

**4.** This Act may be cited as the "Closer Settlement Appropriation Act, 1932," and shall be deemed to have commenced as on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one.
