BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the “ Sydney Harbour Bridge (Rates) Act, 1932.”

2. The Sydney Harbour Bridge Act, 1922, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended by inserting next after subsection one of section nine the following new subsection :—

(1A) For the year one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three and for each succeeding year the rate of one-half of a penny in the pound imposed by subsection one of this section is hereby reduced to a rate of one-third of a penny in the pound.
