

FARMERS' RELIEF (AMENDMENT) ACT.

No. 24, 1933. An Act to amend the Farmers' Relief Act, 1932,
and for purposes connected therewith.
[Assented to, 20th December, 1933.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the “ Farmers' Relief
(Amendment) Act, 1933.”

(2) The Farmers' Relief Act, 1932, as amended
by this Act, may be cited as the Farmers' Relief Act,
1932-1933.

2. The Farmers' Relief Act, 1932, is amended by
omitting from subsection one of section eight the word
“ twelve ” and by inserting in lieu thereof the word
“ fifteen.”
