

HOUSING OF THE UNEMPLOYED (GRANT) ACT.

Act No. 5, 1934.

An Act to appropriate and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales certain sums for the housing of unemployed persons to be paid and applied in accordance with and subject to the provisions of the Housing of the Unemployed Act, 1934. [Assented to, 29th June, 1934.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Housing of the Unemployed (Grant) Act, 1934."

Grant.

2. Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund there is hereby appropriated in the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four, the sum of two hundred thousand pounds to be carried to Special Deposits Account and applied in accordance with and subject to the provisions of the Housing of the Unemployed Act, 1934.

Treasurer
shall pay.

3. The Colonial Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sum in such proportions as the Governor by any warrant or order in writing under his hand and directed to the said Treasurer may from time to time order and direct, and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the said Consolidated Revenue Fund.

Treasurer
shall be

money paid
by him.

4. The said Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum or sums of money paid by him in pursuance of this Act.
