

CROWN LANDS (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 51, 1935.

An Act to extend for a further period certain provisions of the Crown Lands (Amendment) Act, 1932; to amend the said Act; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 16th December, 1935.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Crown Lands (Amendment) Act, 1935."

Short title.

2. The Crown Lands (Amendment) Act, 1932, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended by omitting from section three the words "three years" wherever occurring and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "six years."
