

FLOUR ACQUISITION (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 52, 1935.

George V. An Act to amend the Flour Acquisition Act, No. 52, 1935. 1931-1934, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 16th December, 1935.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title. 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Flour Acquisition (Amendment) Act, 1935."

(2) The Flour Acquisition Act, 1931-1934, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Flour Acquisition Act, 1931-1935."

Amendment of Act No. 10, 1931, s. 2. (Interpretation.) 2. The Flour Acquisition Act, 1931-1934, is amended by omitting from section two the word "thirty-five" occurring in the definition of "wheat" and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "thirty-six."
