

GAMING AND BETTING (AMENDMENT) ACT.

An Act to amend the Gaming and Betting Act, 1912, and certain other Acts in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 4th July, 1936.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the "Gaming and Betting (Amendment) Act, 1936." Short title
and citation.
- (2) The Gaming and Betting Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act. (3)

2. The Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from section fifty-three the words “or within forty miles of the principal post office, Newcastle”;
- (b) by inserting in the same section after the words “Wednesday of that week” the words—

Meetings for greyhound racing on racecourses situate within forty miles of the principal post office, Newcastle, may, subject to this Act, be held on Wednesdays, Saturdays and public holidays, except Good Friday and Christmas Day, and on no other days.
