

DAIRY PRODUCTS (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 47, 1936.

Edward VIII, An Act to amend the Dairy Products Act, 1933,
No. 47, 1936. in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 23rd November, 1936.]

BE

No. 47, 1936.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Dairy Products Short title and citation. (Amendment) Act, 1936."

(2) The Dairy Products Act, 1933, as amended by this Act may be cited as the "Dairy Products Act, 1933-1936."

2. The Dairy Products Act, 1933, is amended—

(a) (i) by inserting in subsection two of section three after the word "manner" the words "and within the time";

(ii) by omitting from subsection three of the same section the words "fourteen days after the commencement of this Act" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "the time prescribed";

(iii) by omitting subsection four of the same section and by inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:—

(4) (a) The term of office of the members of the Board holding office immediately before the commencement of the Dairy Products (Amendment) Act, 1936, shall expire on the twelfth day of January, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven.

(b) The term of office of members of the Board appointed after such commencement (other than a member appointed to fill a casual vacancy) shall expire at the end of a period of three years after the date upon which they assume office as members of the Board.

(c) Any member retiring from office on the expiration of his term of office shall, if otherwise qualified, be eligible for re-appointment.
