

GAMING AND BETTING (AMENDMENT) ACT.

An Act to amend the Gaming and Betting Act, 1912-1936, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 18th November, 1937.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the “Gaming and Betting (Amendment) Act, 1937,” and shall be read and construed with the Gaming and Betting Act, 1912-1936.

2. (1) The number of days upon which meetings for greyhound-racing may be held on Harold Park Racecourse during the period commencing at the commencement of this Act and ending on the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven, shall be six and six only.

(2) The provisions of the Gaming and Betting Act, 1912-1936, shall, subject to subsection one of this section, apply to and in respect of the meetings referred to in that subsection.
